High Voltage Lineman Scholarship Guidelines

Ozarks Electric will award a scholarship to one graduating senior to attend Arkansas State University at Newport, Arkansas for a High Voltage Lineman certification. This scholarship is open to any graduating high school senior living in Ozarks Electric Cooperative's service territory.

The value of this scholarship is \$7,970 and the training is for one calendar year. The High Voltage Lineman certification is equivalent to 42 college credits and provides complete training for a career as an electrical line worker. The scholarship pays for the books, tuition, equipment and fees for the student's training. The recipient will be responsible for room and board.

A complete application should be accompanied by a letter of introduction from the applicant that includes a personal profile and a short essay on why they would like to attend High Voltage Lineman School.
